Brief Explanation:

For more than 20 years, San Diego Unified School District has maintained a cooperative agreement with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). This partnership between the CDC and SDUSD fosters coordinated school health education for youth. As part of our cooperative agreement, every other year we conduct surveys of Principals and Lead Health Teachers to assess the status of school health education at the middle and senior high school levels. The data collected and presented as the School Health Profile will be used to improve the delivery of health education to our students. It will also be used to provide key information to the Coordinated School Health Council and Safe Schools Task Force for use in policy development.
